

As a participant in this driving event, you are responsible for the safety of your car and should know the conditions of all items on the list. The following is a minimum list of items that should be checked by a qualified service facility prior to the event. The safety verification performed at the event is a check of several items; however, it is not a comprehensive technical inspection. The Drivers Edge and designated safety inspectors assume no responsibility for the safety of your vehicle. Any vehicle that does not pass the following safety inspection will not participate in the event. Owners with new cars that have less than 15,000 miles and have NOT been in an accident, can inspect their own vehicles.

-----Certified tech must initial each item -----

- 1. Windshield - no cracks; wipers functional with good blades.
2. Mirrors - securely mounted.
3. Brake Lights - all working.
4. Pedals - throttle & clutch in good operating condition with free return; firm brake pedal.
5. Seat Belts - lap and shoulder belts securely anchored and in good condition.
6. Brakes - More than 50% pad lining, good system pressure, disc above minimum thickness
7. Brake Fluid - clean fluid in reservoir, flushed in last 12 months.
8. Battery - securely fastened with no leaks.
9. Belts - tight with no cracks.
10. Fluids - NO LEAKS of any type any fluid: all hoses secure and pliable: all levels filled properly.
11. Suspension - no worn parts; no loose components.
12. Steering - tight and precise; no worn components and no wandering.
13. Exhaust System - secure and no leaks.
14. Wheel Bearings - no noise or excessive play.
15. Wheels - No cracks, all lugs torque to manufacturer's specifications; valve stems with caps.
16. Tires - minimum tread depth 3/32 of inch (exceptions for race tires); balanced with no leaks.
17. Gas Cap - secure & tight.
18. Accessory Equipment - installed securely with no loose parts.
19. C/V Joints & Axles - no noise or vibration; boots intact.
20. Helmet - 2000 or 2005 Snell rating M or SA.
21. Mandatory Documentation - Attach copy of proof of auto insurance and valid driver's license
22. Convertibles & Roll Bar - Mandatory for all convertibles cars without manufacture's structural or deploying roll bar. Must extend above drivers head. (Applies only to the advanced run groups)
23. Receipt of vehicle inspection must be attached. (If not a T.D.E. tech. inspector)
